General Rules and Guidelines for Ranger's Got Talent

- 1) One submission (talent sample on audio or video) per person or group. A group cannot be more than eight people.
- 2) Participants must be <u>08 years old or older</u>, on date of entry, to compete.
- 3) Videos/Audio submissions must not be more than 1 minute in length. The contestant(s) must identify themselves at the beginning of the video. The identity of the performer must match the name on the entry form.
- 4) The talent selected on the entry form must remain consistent throughout the duration of the talent show. For example: if the participant(s) select vocal as their category, one song can be submitted in the video but another selection can be performed live for the judges & Camp. However, the participant(s) may not switch to an instrument or other talent than was chosen on the entry form.
- 5) Participants must be amateur, and must not be professional performers. All participants will be reviewed to insure that the contestants are amateur.
- 6) No political or inflammatory material will be accepted. All submissions must contain Christ-centered faith oriented material and the participants must be in appropriate attire during any live performances.
- 7) No Ranger leader/commander is eligible to enter this Talent Show.
- 8) We do not discriminate against anyone based on race or ability, to the extent prohibited by law.
- 9) An Outpost commander or leader MUST attend all performances for any Ranger who is participating in the Talent Show.
- 10) Alternates will be chosen in the event a participant(s) cannot attend all performances or is disqualified for any reason. All participants who have been selected to move forward to the next level of participation will be notified by

email. All participants will have 4 minutes to display their talent on Ranger's Got Talent Night.

- 11) By signing the waiver, the participant(s) agrees to adhere to all the rules and guidelines set forth on this document.
- 12) All submissions received become the property of FMD Royal Rangers ministry. Participants grant permission to FMD Royal Rangers to use any photographs, videos, and recordings from performances on any and all platforms and/or social media.
